

## The Flies We Use

Tying the Bucktail Deceiver

**Good for Sea Trout and Snook** 

Silver

Crystal

Flash







White

thread





Peacock

Herl



Crystal Flash





Start the thread at the eve and wind it down to the bend in the hook.



Tie on two strands of silver crystal flash near the hook eye. Crystal flash should extend past the tail.



Drip thick head cement between the eyes, top and bottom, to create the Deceiver's head.

**Hooks Size 2** 

Tie on the Deceiver's tail using white bucktail (on top of the silver crystal flash).



Tie on two strands of Peacock Herl.



White & Green Bucktail

To create the Deceiver's silver body, wrap the silver crystal flash forward to the hook eye and tie down.



Turn the fly upside down and tie on the gills (red crystal flash) Trim to approximately 1/4".



Tie on the Deceiver's white bucktail body near the hook eye. Body should extend past tail.



Add the glue-on eyes.

## Fishing the Bucktail Deceiver

Cast it over weed beds and let it sink to the desired depth but keep it above the weeds. Pull it through the water with









Near the hook bend, tie on the silver crystal flash. You'll wrap the silver flash forward to the hook's eye once you tie on the tail.



Tie on the green bucktail body. It should extend a little past the white bucktail body.



The finished product.
