

Tying the Schwimmer Minnow

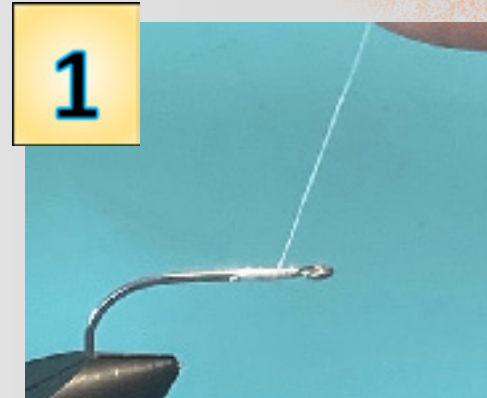

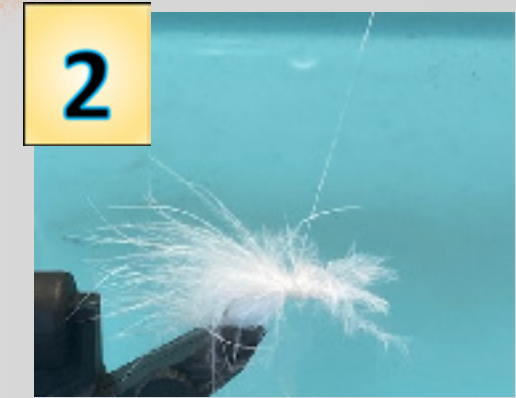


What you'll need:

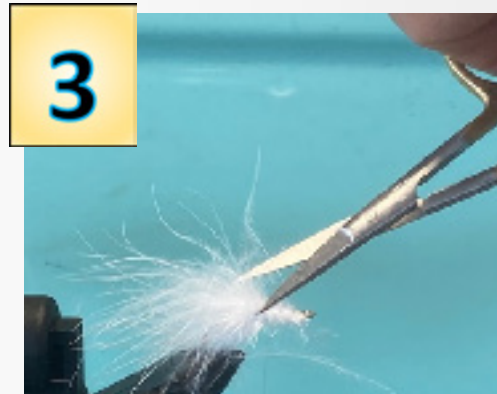
1. #1 or #2 Saltwater Hooks
2. White Marabou Feathers
3. Crystal Chenille
4. Black Eye Beads
5. Pearl Flash
6. White Thread



1 Start the thread midway down the #1 or #2 hook.



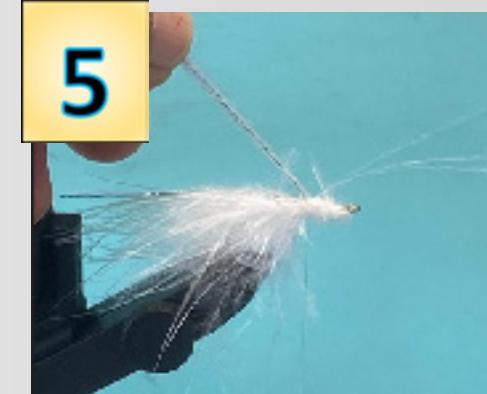
2 Tie on the Marabou feathers 2/3 of the way down the hook.



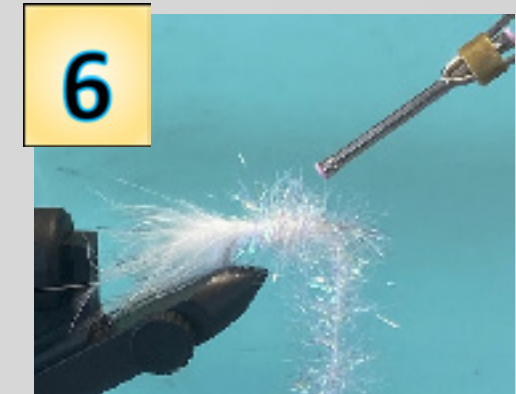
3 Trim the excess Marabou feathers forward of the tie point.



4 Tie on a small amount of Pearl Flash.



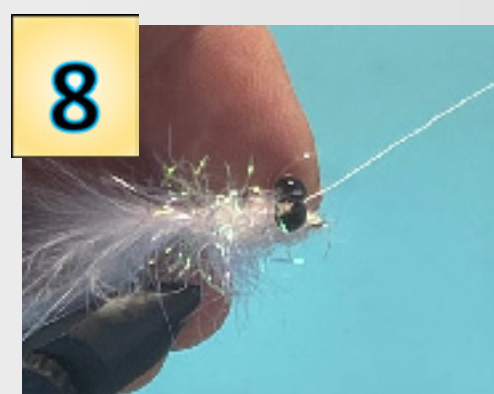
5 Pull the front part of the Pearl Flash back over the tie point and tie it down. Trim the Crystal Flash a touch longer than the Marabou feathers.



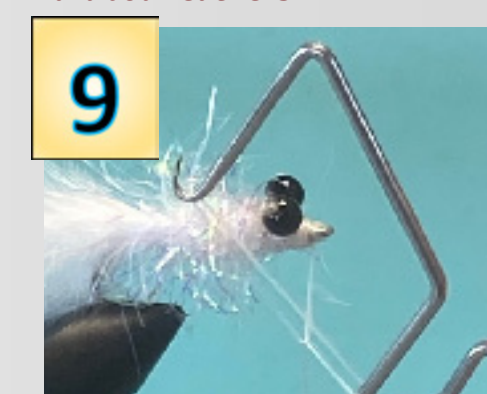
6 Tie on the Crystal Chenille at the Midway point and wrap it forward. Smooth the bristles upward as you wrap.



7 Trim the excess Crystal Chenille near the hook eye.



8 Tie on the Black Eye Beads



9 Whip finish the fly



10 Brush on Super Glue to set the eyes and final wrap in place.
